E it Ordained by the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council convened, That every liceused Hackney Coach, Carriage and Sleigh, when used or driven in the night, shall have fixed up on some conspicuous part on the outside thereof, a lighted Lamp with glass front and sides, and the Licensed number thereof placed on the front and sides of such lamp, in plain legible figures of at least two inches in length, with no other figure or device thereon, so that the same may be distinctly seen. And if any person or persons
