

Anti-Slavery Convention.

NEW-YORK, N. Y., June 27.—The Anti-Slavery Convention of ultra Abolitionists, assembled in this city yesterday. James McCune Smith of New York, was chosen President, and a platform adopted on the basis that human slavery is unconstitutional and wicked wherever existing. The object of the Convention is to harmonize feelings and produce unity of action among the class of anti-slavery men, known as ultra Abolitionists. The Convention continues its session through to-morrow.
