

**ARREST OF NED BENTLINE FOR SHOOTING A COLORED MAN.**—The Bath (Me.) Mirror contains the following dispatch, dated Bowdoinham, Me., October 21th:—

E. C. Judson, alias Ned Bentline, was arrested this afternoon by Marshal Walker, on a charge of shooting a person or persons near Bay Bridge.—Ned says he was assaulted by a mob of Irish, who seized his horse, and that he fired on them, upon which they fled. The person referred to as having been shot was a colored man named Freeman. By his account of the affair, it appears Ned was the aggressor. As Judson has been arrested, the matter will be thoroughly investigated, when we shall be able to give a true statement of the whole affair. The ball entered the fleshy part of the thigh, causing a serious wound, and is so deeply imbedded that it has been impossible to extract it.
