

Capacity Audience Forecast For \$100 GOP Dinner Here

A capacity audience will greet Sen. Knowland (R-Calif.) at the Republican \$100-a-plate dinner at 7 p.m. Sept. 12 in El Cortez Hotel, it was announced yesterday.

Charles K. Fletcher, dinner chairman, said reservations for the dinner have passed the 500 mark. He did not state what he considered the capacity to be. Fletcher spoke at a meeting of the dinner committee in the San Diego Club yesterday.

At the same meeting he announced that Sen. Knowland will be honor guest at a public reception in the U. S. Grant Hotel at 2 p.m. Sept. 13.

The dinner committee yesterday was told the elephant

motif will prevail in decorations for the GOP dinner Sept. 12.

Fletcher said the dinner committee is engaged in filling the more than 500 reservations.

"We are getting the tickets out to those who made the reservations," he said. "Each

ticket will be marked with the table for which the seat was reserved. We hope this will tend to avoid confusion in seating."

Details of the dinner program, are to be submitted for approval at a budget committee meeting this afternoon, Fletcher said.

The congressman said he regretted failure of pay raises for the military services, postal workers and civil service employees. He said he supported these measures, but also has supported economy legislation.

The Congress began to take on an unreal appearance for him, said Wilson "when I saw so-called liberals and free spenders like Rep. Roosevelt (D-Calif.) calling for economy."

Wilson said he expects to leave San Diego this week and Washington next week on a trip to inspect Navy and Sixth Fleet operations in the Mediterranean.

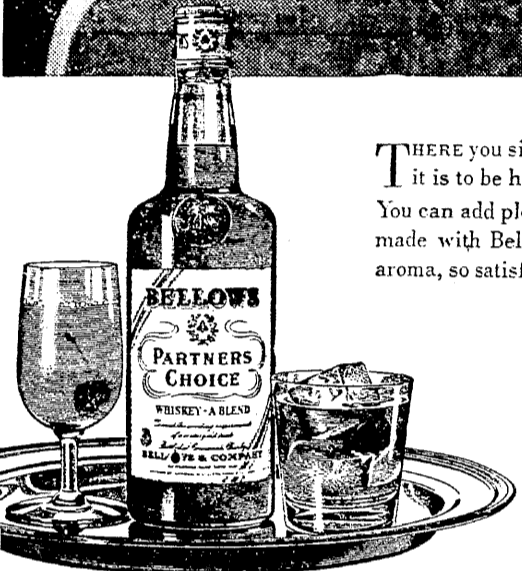
