

Red Warns U. S. In 'Open Letter'

MOSCOW (AP) — A commentator in the newspaper Izvestia addressed an "open letter to America" based on this week's accident involving a Bomarc missile in New Jersey.

A page-one, three-column story by V. Kudryatsev emphasized the Soviet policy line calling for the outlawing of all nuclear weapons. Accompanying the article were illustrations showing a Bomarc in flight, an aerial view of the missile base and a section of an American road map pinpointing the nearness of Philadelphia and New York to the site.

Kudryatsev said he made a visit to the United States in 1956 and Americans told him they feared nuclear war would break out. He said the incident at McGuire Air Force Base took the dangers beyond the talking stage.

"You can't hope to draw a magic circle around your little towns and expect to be safe inside it," he said.
