About Captain Fry. This fiery rebel was Henry P. Fry, a Southerner of many generations descent, born and reared in East Tennessee and making his home in Chattanooga. He is 40 years old. He is a graduate of that old Southern institution, the Virginia Military Institute, was once commandant of cadets at Sewanee, in the University of the South, and was for a long time a Captain in the Tennessee National Const

At the outbreak of the war he enlisted as a private in the regular army at Camp Meade, Md., was sent to Company A. 316th Infantry, made Sergeant, and transferred to the en-listed men's training school at Camp Gordon, Ga. There he was commissioned a Second Lieutenant, sent sioned a Second Lieutenant, sent to Camp Perry, Ohio, made a First Lieutenant there: sent to Camp Funston, Kan., and there, under Gen-eral Leonard Wood, served through the rest of the war as a rifle spe-cialist and instructor in infantry rifle practice. He was recommended for a commission as Major when the war ended and he was ordered home with a commission as Captain of Infantry Reserve Corps.
