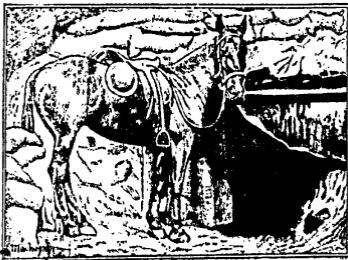


FAITHFUL WAR HORSE AWAITS MASTER IN VAIN.



The official British photograph shown here depicts a pathetic scene on the La Basse front. A handsome horse, the mount of a British officer, is standing at the edge of a dugout, into which his master has gone never to return. An unfamiliar hand will lead him away from the scene of his master's death. In the picture the face of the horse seems almost to bear a grieved look. In the last year many stories have come from the front telling of horses that have been known to pine away in sorrow after their masters have been killed.
